

National Lung Cancer Screening Program (NLCSP)

Jones Radiology is a participating radiology service for the Medicare funded NLCSP.

Lung cancer remains the number one cancer killer* in Australia. For high-risk patients, a Low Dose CT (LDCT) scan can detect lung cancer early, improving treatment outcomes and saving lives.

About the NLCSP

Eligible patients will receive a bulk-billed Low-Dose CT (LDCT) chest scan, which includes:

- A structured radiology report that ensures a nationally standardised approach.
- Registration of results in:
 - The National Cancer Screening Register.
 - · My Health Record.
- Follow-up recommendations and routine re-screening based on scan results.

Who is Eligible?

Patients who meet all the below listed criteria:

- Are aged 50 to 70 years.
- · Have no signs or symptoms of lung cancer.
- Smoke tobacco cigarettes or have quit within the last 10 years.
- Have a smoking history of 30+ pack-years.

Note: Eligibility must be assessed by the referring GP and noted on the referral form.

How to Refer

- 1. Confirm patient meets criteria.
- 2. Enrol patient in National Cancer Screening Register.
- 3. Complete the National Lung Cancer Screening Program request form (preferred) or a Jones Radiology request form.
- 4. If using a Jones Radiology request form you must include:
 - that the scan is for lung cancer screening as part of NLCSP
 - · family history of lung cancer in any first-degree relative
 - · details of any previous chest CT and history of any cancer.

Results and Follow-Up

Results and recommended actions are sent to the referring GP via the National Cancer Screening Register and usual channels.

- Patients with no findings are recalled every **2 years**.
- Patients with findings receive follow-up reminders as needed.
- We will continue to manage critical findings following our existing processes.

A new request form must be completed for every scan including interval follow-ups and two yearly recalls.
